## VENDOR INVITATION

The Eastport Pirate Festival has become one of the marquee family events on the Coast of Maine and Atlantic Canada in 5 short years.

Last year the festival attracted over 10,000 people during the 3 days of events.

Over the past four years the Eastport Pirate Festival was held the same weekend as the Salmon Festival in Eastport. The vendors have always been part of the Salmon Festival. This year, 2010 will see the Salmon Festival celebrated Labor Day Weekend and the Pirate Festival will unfold the next weekend, September 10th through 12th.

This year marks the first year that the Pirate Festival will also host the first International Lobster Boat Race - Pirate style of Course! The Lobster Boat Races on the coast of Maine happen at ten locations on the Coast of Maine throughout the summer. They draw big crowds that come for the day to enjoy the festivities on both land and sea. We already have two of the top names on the Lobster Boat Racing Circuit committed to be part of our inaugural race so the Pirate Festival crowds should be substantial for everyone involved.

### EASTPORT PIRATE FESTIVAL 2010 VENDOR INFO

1. Each space will be 10 ft. x 12 ft. Vendor locations will be clearly marked. Any vendor using additional space will be charged for another vending area.
2. Rates: All spaces shall be \$100.00 for the 3 day period. There will be a \$25.00 additional charge for vendors who require electricity and/or water.  
Dates: Vending set-up on Friday Noon, September 10th through September 12th at 5PM
3. Vendors may reserve no more than four spaces. A confirmation will be sent when vending area has been determined.
4. Payment must be cash, certified check or money order. Personal checks will only be accepted until August 10th.
5. We reserve the right to approve vendors and jury items sold.
6. Vendor shall state what type of ware to be sold. No illegal or dangerous merchandise will be allowed. Nothing that litters the streets or is competing with existing local businesses.
7. Vehicles will be allowed in the vending area for loading and unloading only. "Camping out" in the vending area only permitted upon approval.
8. Vendors will not be allowed to sell their wares outside of assigned areas. There will be no vending on streets or sidewalks.
9. Vendors will be responsible for clean-up of their assigned area and immediate surroundings.
10. Vendors will adhere to all instructions of the Eastport City Manager, Police, Fire Chief, and Pirate Festival Committee Vendor Committee. Failure to do so will result in immediate termination of vendor privileges.
11. All vending shall cease at 5 PM on September 12th.
